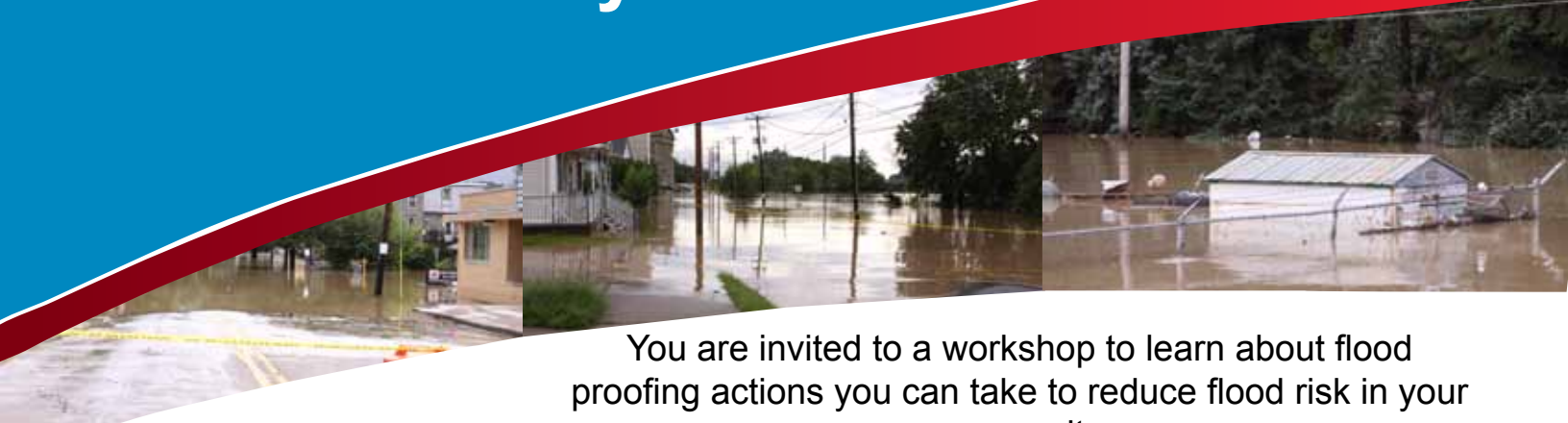


Flood Proofing Workshop for Community Officials



You are invited to a workshop to learn about flood proofing actions you can take to reduce flood risk in your community.

This is your chance to receive training on different types of nonstructural flood proofing techniques from the U.S. Army Corps of Engineers National Nonstructural Flood Proofing Committee. The flood proofing discussion will include topics on elevating buildings, wet and dry flood proofing, relocation/acquisition, and nonstructural berms/floodwalls. You also will hear about federal and state programs available to assist your community with flood proofing.

Federal and state agency representatives will be on hand to discuss other floodplain management topics, such as the National Flood Insurance Program and Community Rating System.
