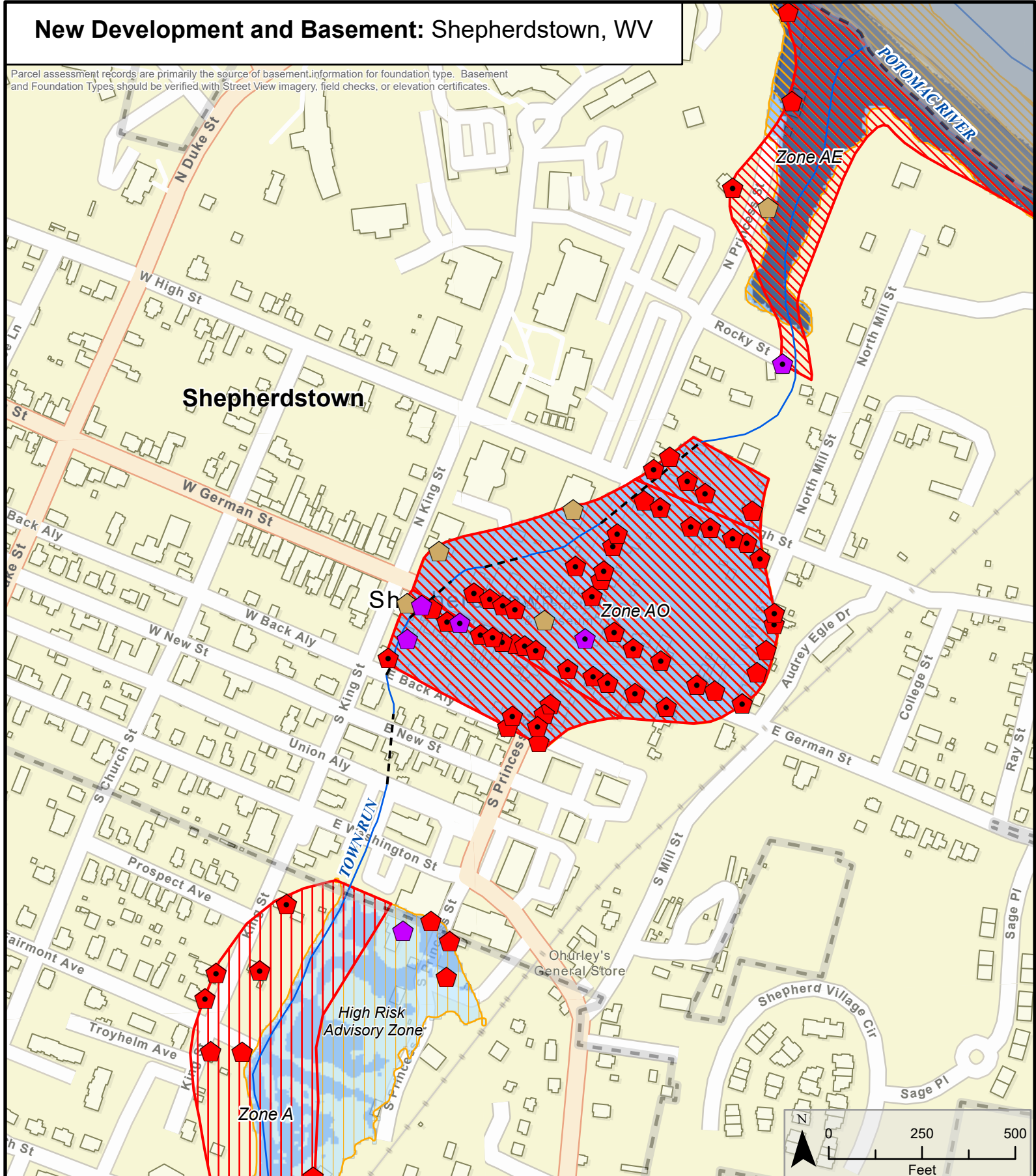


# New Development and Basement: Shepherdstown, WV

Parcel assessment records are primarily the source of basement information for foundation type. Basement and Foundation Types should be verified with Street View imagery, field checks, or elevation certificates.
