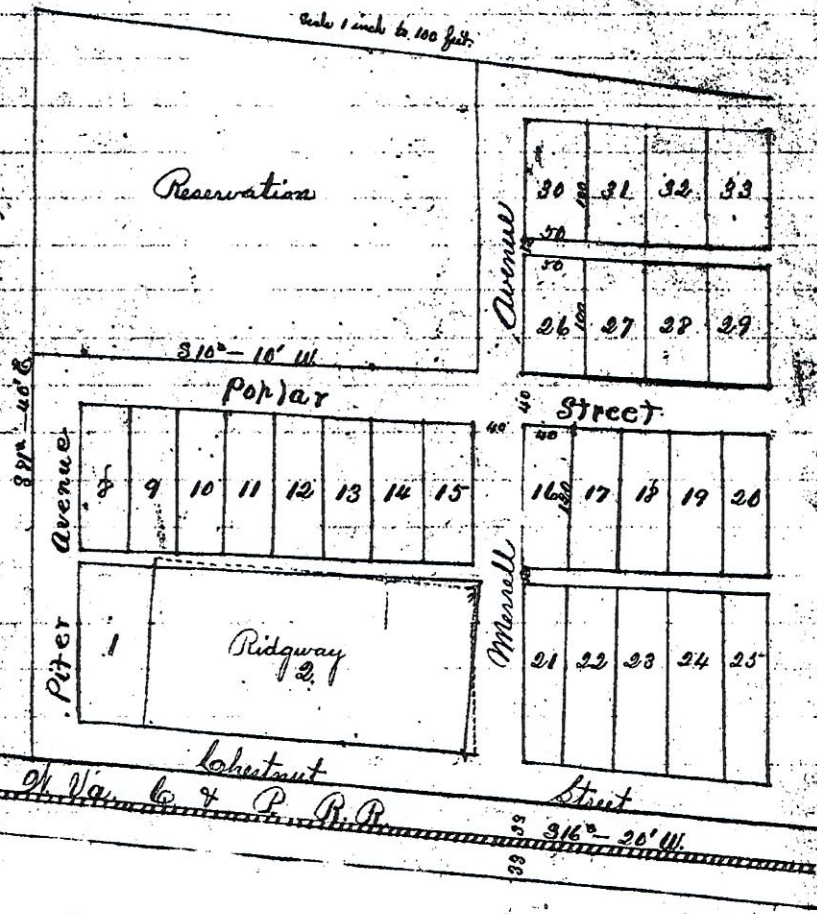


MAP OF PIFERS

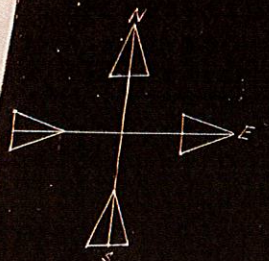

This deed made this 16th day of August A.D. between Mrs. Lydia J. Heaton of the first part and F. S. Landstreet of the second part.

Witnesseth that for and in consideration of the sum of four thousand (\$4,000.00) dollars five hundred (\$500.00) dollars cash in hand paid the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, and a demand note for thirty five hundred (\$3,500.00) dollars bearing even date with this deed, the said party of the first part does grant, bargain, sell and convey unto the said party of the second part all that lot situated in the town of Davis, in the county of Tucker and State of West Virginia, known and numbered on the map of said town as laid off by A. G. Davis, J. B. Davis and Hollie D. Elkins, former owners as lot number two hundred and twelve (212) fronting one hundred and fifty two feet on Henry Avenue and running back one hundred and twenty (120) feet to an alley, bounded on the east side by lot number two hundred and thirteen (213) and on the west side by Fourth Street. A lien is hereby retained to secure the demand note above mentioned. To have and to hold said lot with all the appurtenances thereunto belonging unto the said party of the second part and his heirs and assigns forever. And the party of the second part covenants that she will warrant specially the property herein conveyed. In testimony whereof the said Lydia J. 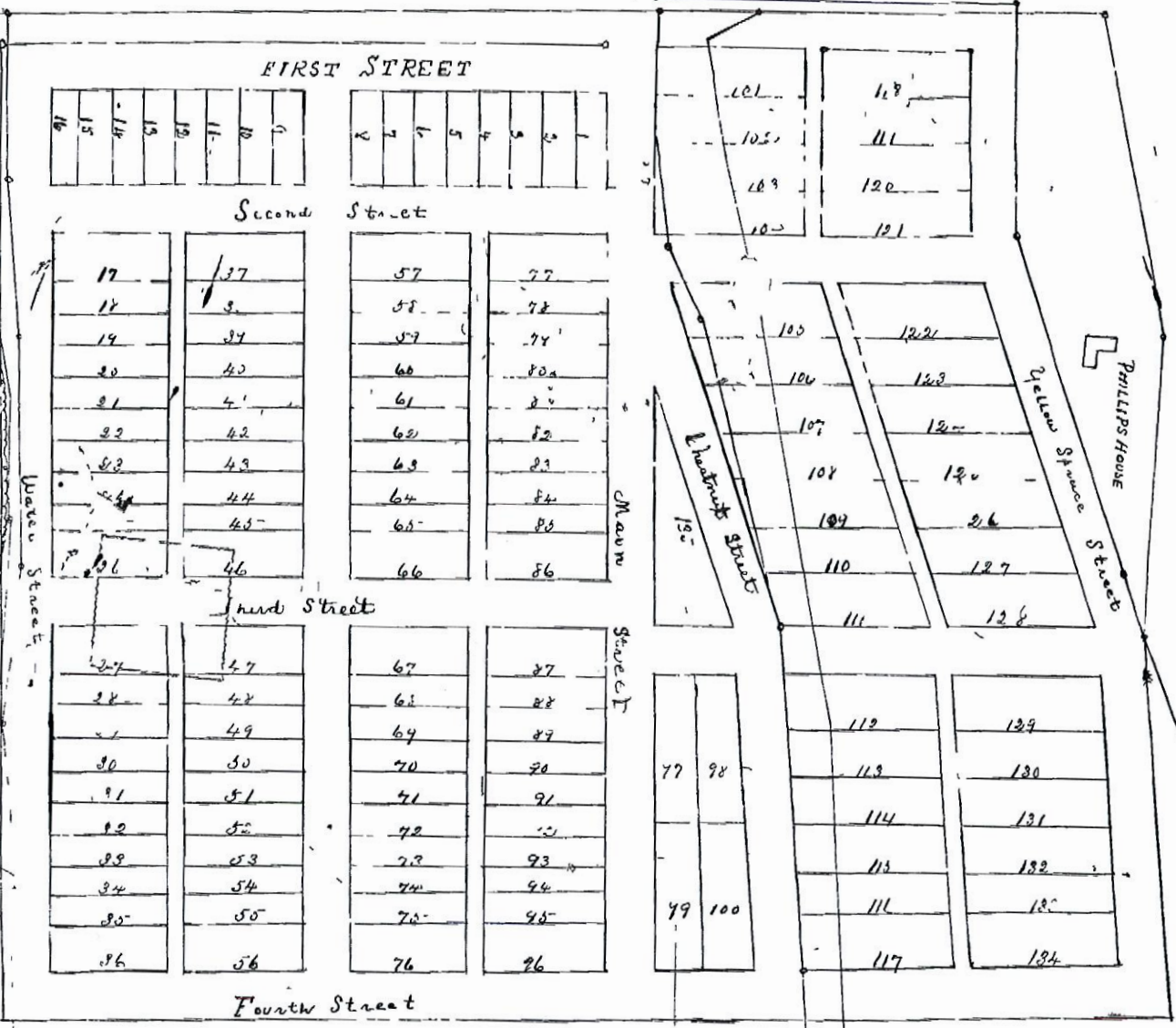
DAVIS ADDITION

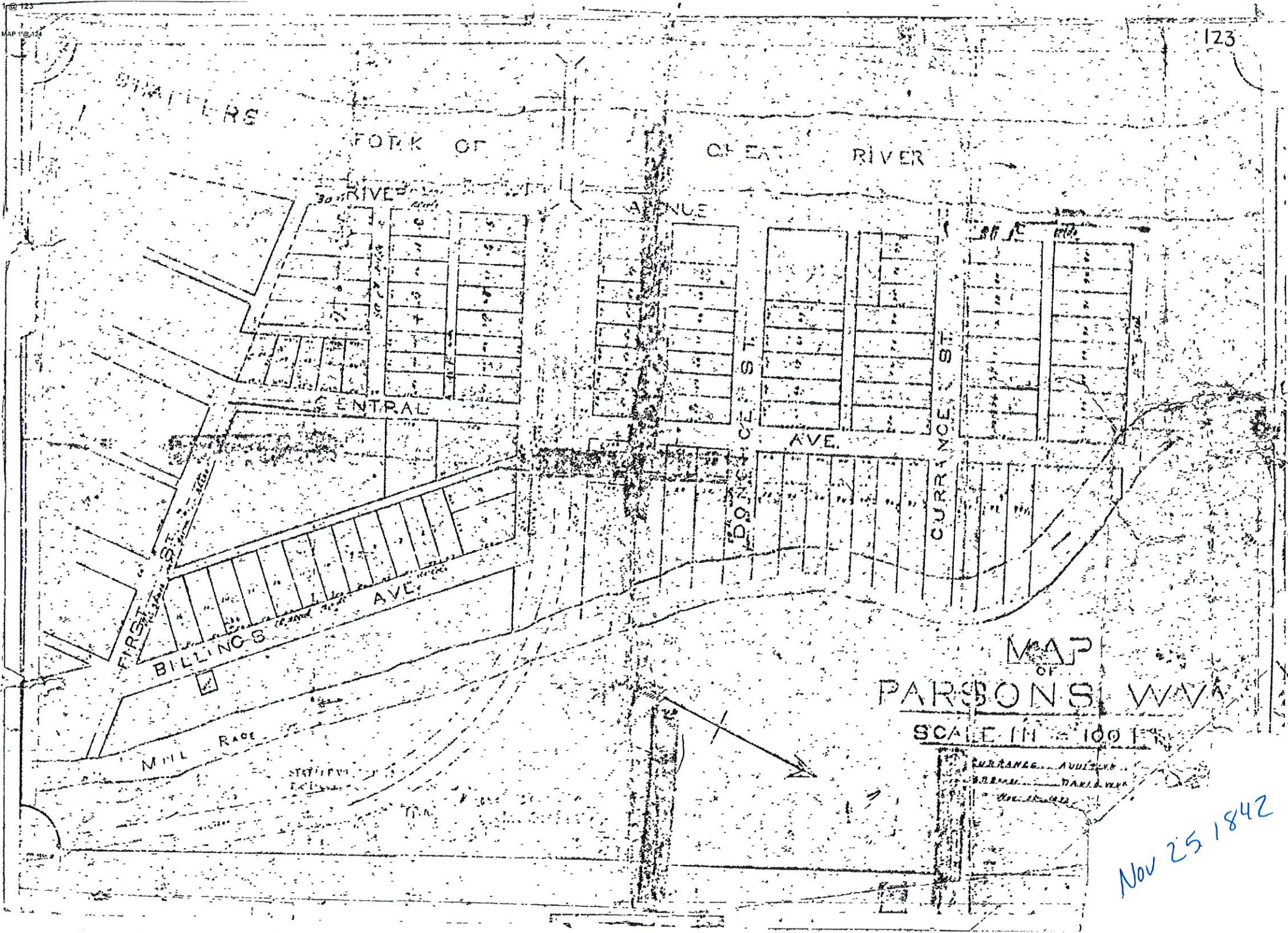
