At a Circuit Court held for the County of Tucker at the Court House thereof, on Saturday, June 28, 1919.

Present the Hon^{ble} F. M. Reynolds. Judge.

In the matter of the Incorporation of the Town of Hambleton in this county by the name of Hambleton.

It appearing to the court from the certificate of J. D. Collett, P. B. Goff and D. B. Harman, that a majority of the qualified voters of said Town have voted in favor of the incorporation of the said town by the name of Hambleton and the court being satisfied by proof that all the provisions of sections 2, 3, 4, 5, 6, 7 and 8 of Chapter 47 of the Code of West Virginia, have been complied with; it is therefore ordered and directed that the Clerk of this Court do issue a certificate of the incorporation of said town or substance as follows; "certificate under oath of J. D. Collett, P. B. Goff and D. B. Harman was this day filed showing that a majority of all the qualified voters residing in the following boundary to-wit: Beginning at a point in the public road, corner of the corporation of Hendricks, West Virginia, hence with the public road, and the south side of the same, N. 56 W 15 poles, 17 links, N 38 W 12 poles, 5 links, N 58 $\frac{1}{2}$ W 25-8/10 poles; N 64 W 16 poles; N 75 $\frac{1}{2}$ W 11 poles, "11 poles" 15 links; N 68 $\frac{1}{2}$ W 20, 16 links; N 56 W 16 poles, 11 Links; N 44 W 13 poles, 6 links; N 57 $\frac{1}{2}$ W 16 poles, 2 links. E same bearing N 37 $\frac{1}{2}$ E 56 $\frac{3}{4}$ poles to the beginning, 160 acres." have been given in due form of law in favor of the incorporation of the Town of Hambleton, by the name of Hambleton in the county of Tucker, bounded as hereinbefore set forth, and it appearing to the satisfaction of the court that all of the provisions of Chapter forty seven of the Code of West Virginia, "has" been complied with by the applicants of said incorporation and said Town of Hambleton by the name of Hambleton is duly authorized with the corporate limit aforesaid to exercise the corporate powers conferred by the said chapter from and after the date of this certificate, the court doth appoint P. B. Giff, J. D. Collett and D. B. Harman, three legal voters residing in said territory who shall act as commissioners of election at the first election to be held in said Town as provided in said chapter of the Code in case they fail or refuse to act the said election may be held by any three legal voters of said town as provided by law.
