Event Details:

Date: July 1888

• Flood Type: Summer Thunderstorm

• Fatalities: 20

• Main Impacted Streams: Caldwell Run (George Run), Wheeling Creek, Little Wheeling Creek

Location: Ohio County, WV (all fatalities occurred here)

Mitigation Efforts:

Stream Gauge present on 70% of fatality locations along Ohio River

Risk and Impact Analysis:

- Flood Zone Classification:
 - o 81.8% in Zone AE
 - 13.6% Unmapped (including 1 fatality on Washington St. swept away in a car, 2 fatalities in Riverview area above flood zone)
- Cause of Death:
 - o 18 by drowning
 - o 1 due to pre-existing medical conditions
- Fatality Locations:
 - 11 in structures
 - o 2 in water

Demographics of Victims:

- Age Groups:
 - o 5 children (0-12)
 - 3 young adults (19-39)
 - o 3 middle-aged adults (40-70)
 - 1 old adult (70+)
- Gender Distribution: Equal, 10 female and 10 male

Mass Casualty Events (65% of fatalities):

• Three houses swept away on Caldwell Run, drowning all residents:



- o Hawley Family: 5 victims swept away; father escaped to safety by the bank
- Stenzel/Wingert Household: Included mother, daughter, son, and two nieces. John Homan attempted rescue; flood waters swept the house from its foundation, killing multiple generations
